Due to availability, there may be some changes in species and or percent of species.

Taylor's Perennial Wildflower Mix is made up of all perennials, 17 species that will provide many colors for years of enjoyment. When fall planted, the flowers will blossom the following spring. When spring planted, if the conditions are right, there will be some flowering, but most will not flower until the following spring. The advantage of spring or summer planting, is that the plants have a well-established root system for the following spring. This mix will grow to an approximate height of 36-40 inches under normal conditions.

Approx. seeds per pound: 400,000

Seeding rate: 7-12 pounds per acre depending on
density desired
1 pound per 3,900 square feet

If Hydro seeding, seeding rate should be doubled.
